Stars' and 'Australian Idol; as a Musicals Guitarist in 'Les Miserables' and 'Dirty Dancing' – as a Festival Performer at Thredbo Jazz Festivals with Daryl Aberhart and Louise Perryman, Bellingen Jazz Festivals, Darling Harbour Jazz Festivals, Manly Jazz Festivals with Jade MacRae, Doug Parkinson and Daryl Aberhart; and as a Solo Performer at various corporate and private functions. David has a wealth of experience and diversity as a musician.

David is a multi instrumentalist playing Guitar, Bass, Organ and Drums.
