performed by the Sydney Philharmonia Motet Choir, London vocal ensemble Sounds Wicked, Synergy Percussion, Halcyon, Ensemble Offspring, pianist Stephanie MacCallum, the Sydney Conservatorium Symphony Orchestra and the Australian Youth Orchestra Camerata.

She is currently completing a PhD in Composition at the Sydney Conservatorium with Michael Smetanin.
