Professor Tony Shannon was formerly Foundation Dean of the University Graduate School, Professor of Applied Mathematics, and Chair of the Key University Research Centre for Health Technologies at UTS. He was also formerly Master of Warrane College at UNSW between 2001 and 2010.

His additional list of credentials include: AUQA Auditor; Subject Specialist, Hong Kong Accreditation Agency; member of the Board of Trustees at Campion College; and is a higher education consultant at several Australian private colleges.

He is co-author of numerous books and articles in medicine, mathematics and education. His research interests are in the philosophy of education and epidemiology, particularly through the application of generalized nets and intuitionistic fuzzy logic. He has taught and mentored at all levels from primary school to post-doctoral.

In June 1987 he was appointed a Member of the Order of Australia for services to education.
